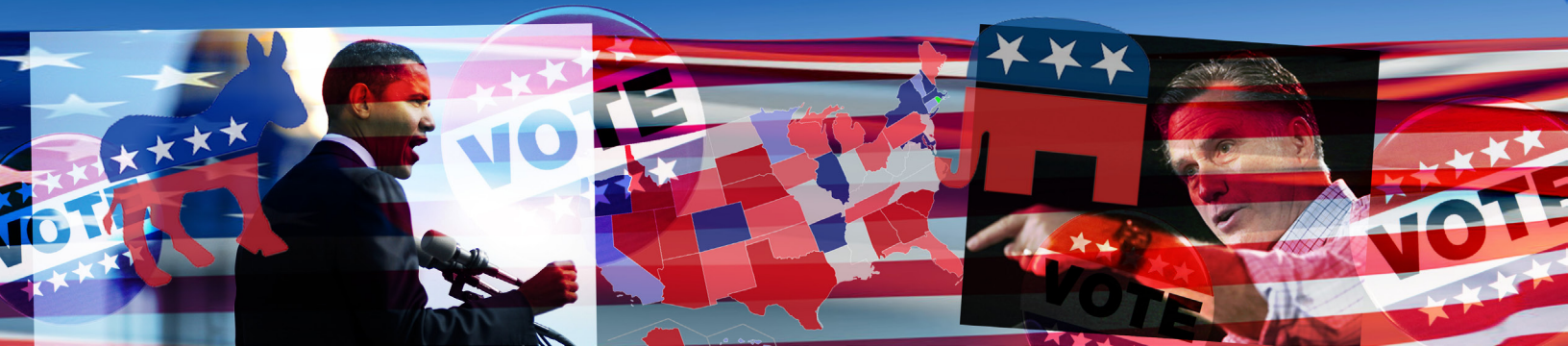


Conscience Under Pressure: Being Faithful Citizens in an Imperfect World
